CAGE TIP

Make sure your bird always has clean water and food. Your bird should always have these things available. When giving your bird cooked or fresh food, make sure it is removed in a timely fashion, about an hour in the summer heat. Never let it sit overnight.



For those of you who bought Birdie Bread at the fair:

Here is the recipe:

Jiffy muffin mix- as per instructions minus the the brown sugar. (Substitute 2 eggs)

1 cup of berries

1/2 cup of quick oatmeal or Quinoa Flakes.

1/2 teaspoon cinnamon

Mix well and pour in a greased muffin tin or an 8 x 9 inch greased pan

Bake @ 375 for 30

minutes, check with a toothpick. The top should be lightly browned. The toothpick should come out clean.

You can substitute banana, apple, or whatever.


